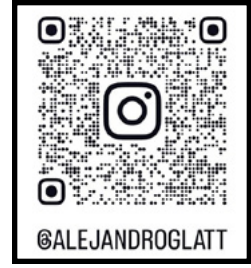




presents: **Alejandro Glatt**



Alejandro Glatt is a Jewish Mexican artist, curator, and cultural producer recognized for creating contemporary artworks that celebrate Jewish identity, resilience, and cultural continuity.

In 2024, he became the first Jewish Mexican artist to send artwork to the Moon through the Artemis / Lunaprise mission. His next lunar mission will send the world's first Mezuzah to the Moon, continuing his exploration of the intersection between contemporary art, Jewish heritage, and space exploration. Following the events of October 7, 2023, his work has become a celebration of Jewish pride, Zionism, resilience, and hope through contemporary pop art.

ARTIST STATEMENT

Being Jewish is fundamental to my life. My work explores how contemporary art can preserve culture, strengthen identity, and build community. As a Jewish Mexican artist, I reinterpret Jewish symbols through a contemporary visual language that celebrates resilience, freedom, memory, and joy.

The events of October 7, 2023, transformed my practice forever. Rather than responding to hate with silence, I chose to answer it through color, creativity, and optimism. Every mezuzah, every collage, and every exhibition becomes an act of Jewish continuity and cultural resilience.
