New York City-based Jewish artist Lilian Kebudi was born in Brazil and moved to the United States in 1997. After an 18-year career as a graphic designer in New York's fashion industry, she now brings her creativity to her painting practice.

Since childhood, art has been her way of expressing her emotions and navigating life's changes. Lilian works intuitively, without overthinking her lines, creating free-flowing organic forms. Her pieces convey movement through unconventional lines while finding balance in asymmetrical shapes. Her color palette evokes calm and tranquility.

October 7 marked the beginning of a new phase in her work, deepening her connection to her Jewish identity and giving birth to the series *Could Be Me*, *Blue Period*, and *One Shabbat at a Time*. Through expressive compositions, she explores memory, ritual, and what it means to be a Jewish woman in a time of war and antisemitism.

In response to the challenges faced by Jewish and Israeli artists, Lilian co-founded Stars in the Arts with artist Annette Back, creating opportunities to exhibit and support Jewish and Israeli artists around the world.
